

California - Proposition 65

Proposition 65, officially the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, is a law that requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

The following have been compiled based on the listed chemicals from the Proposition 65 web site. Some of these items are optional components and are not found in all fixtures that we sell. Also, keep in mind that these are fixtures that are not normally handled regularly after installation, so our goal is simply to provide the information so that Californians can make an informed decision about their level of exposure to these chemicals.

Acrylic products - Lenses and Louvers

Electrical Cords

Fiberglass & Styrene - Louvers
